## FOOD & FUEL PRICES PUSH INFLATION DOWN TO -0.4% IN DECEMBER


The Statistical Institute of Belize's latest statistics show that for the month of December 2014, the All-Items Consumer Price Index stood at 103.3, a decline of 0.4 percent from 103.6 in last December. This represented the first overall decline in consumer prices recorded since May 2013 and was driven by a sharp drop in fuel prices coupled with a slower but steady decline in food prices.

The price per gallon of all three types of fuel fell considerably in comparison to December 2013, with the price of premium and regular gasoline down by about 22 percent and 17 percent, respectively, while that of diesel was more than 20 percent lower. Similarly, international airfares were down by 17 percent from the same month last year. On average, food prices were 1.8 percent lower, with the most notable decreases being seen in fresh vegetables, eggs, and Red Kidney beans.

Inflation for the category of 'Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels' remained at about 1 percent, reflecting higher home rental prices, which were up by 1.5 percent. This overshadowed the effects of lower butane prices during the month, as the average price of 100 pound cylinder dropped more than \$10 from \$119.85 in December 2013 to \$109.26.

Notwithstanding the slowdown in inflation recorded during the last five months, the national inflation rate for the year 2014 was 1 percent, with home rentals, transport, some food items, and insurance premiums driving this increase through the year.


Figure 3: Inflation Rates by Municipality (Percent);


