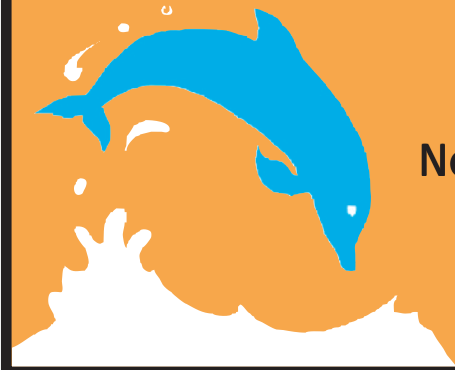

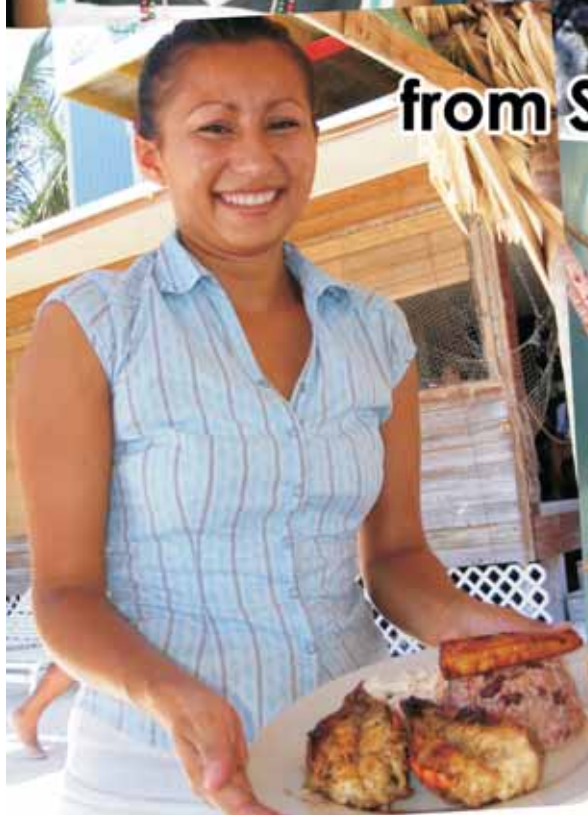

will involve a variety of planned activities that include a Lobsterfest pub crawl (starting at Lime and ending at Wet Willy's), All-you-can-eat Lobster Pizza at Pedro's Pizza, and dinner at Captain Morgan's Retreat.

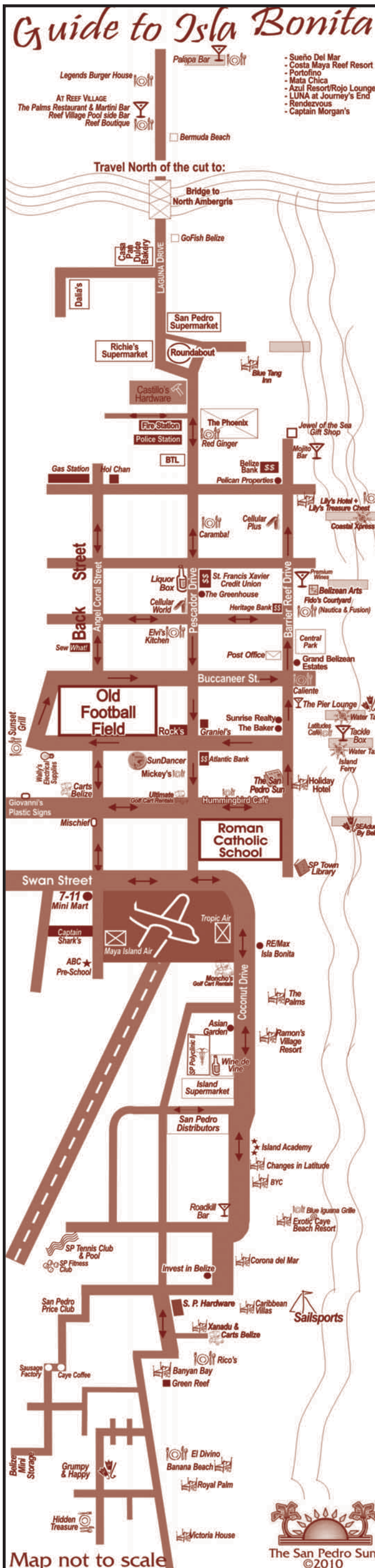
